

Bari Airport to the Trullo: A step-by-step guide.

It may look more complicated than it is, this is so you have points of reference as you move along couple of roads it is to get there.

Leaving the airport, follow exit signs. You will go over a couple of speed bumps. On arrival at the traffic lights, turn left.

Go straight ahead and bear left after a few hundred metres, following the signs to the 'Autostrader' (they're in green).

Move into the right hand lane as you go around the corner and up the hill, following signs to Brindisi (In Blue).

Take exit marked for Brindisi.

Remain on the motorway for about 25 - 30 minutes.

Look out for signs to Alberobello. It is clearly signposted.

Exit at turn off to Alberobello.

Note: When you exit the motorway, take care, as Italian slip roads are shorter than we are used to in the UK.

Follow the signs to Alberobello. There will be a junction and you will need to turn right.

This road will take you all the way into Alberobello.

You will pass huge Olive trees on your left and right and the road will bear left as you head up over the mountains.

This is a steep, windy road, with the views we spoke about earlier.

As you leave the mountain road and start heading down into the valley, you will meet a crossroads. Carry straight on.

You will follow this easy-winding road all the way into Alberobello; you will have your first experience of the Trulli as you enter the 'Zona di Trulli'.

The road winds and turns until you go around a right turn and head up a hill to a roundabout. You have arrived at Alberobello. Told you it was only two roads.

Turn left at the roundabout and follow the road until you see signs for Noci and a main right turn exit. Take the exit.

Follow the road up the hill to the roundabout.

Go straight over the roundabout, continuing up the hill. There is a new hotel on your left as you leave the roundabout and go up the hill.

Follow this main road. You will pass over two crossroads.

The road will fork off to the right, and goes down a sharp hill. Keep in the left lane (It's one way) and turn left at the bottom.

Keep straight, still following the signs to Noci.

You will go under a bridge, and as the main road bears off to the right, straight ahead you will see a little road/lane heading straight. You need to take this exit, Left off the main road.

Follow this road and take the 2nd left heading down to the railway crossing. It's an automatic crossing.

Follow this road up the hill until you reach the Trullo on your left hand side.
